Safe Transportation of Food Responsibility

Food must be brought to the center in clean, insulated, sanitizable containers, which keeps cold food at 41 degrees F and hot food at 140 degrees F.

Upon receiving the food from the parent, the center shall verify the temperature of the food. When potentially hazardous food temperature is not correct, the center will not accept the food.

Upon accepting the food, the center shall maintain correct food temperatures until served.
